

Dangerous Goods Provisions for Passengers & Crew

The following reference table summarizes allowable goods that may be carried onboard aircraft at Near North Aviation that are deemed dangerous provided that the allowable quantities and means of carriage are followed.

The Pilot will ensure that the aircraft is loaded correctly using the Provisions & Limitations Table for initial guidance. Additionally, reference to the IATA Dangerous Goods Manual (TAB-2 Limitations) maybe be required for additional handling guidance. The Pilot reserves the right to still refuse the dangerous goods in the table regardless of the provisions and guidelines being followed at his or her discretion.

Thermometer, medical or clinical (which contains mercury).	1 per person only when in protective case.	Baggage Only.
Thermometer or barometer, mercury filled. (carried by a representative of a government weather bureau or similar official agency). Air operator approval is required. Must be packed in a strong outer packaging having a sealed inner liner or a bag of strong leak proof and puncture resistant material impervious to mercury which will prevent its escape of mercury from the package irrespective of its position. The Pilot in Command must know its location.	N/A	PIC to be informed of location. Carry on Only.
